#### Notes to the accounts

- i The financial statements of the P.C.C. have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 using the Receipts & Payments basis.
- ii General funds represent the funds of the P.C.C. that are not subject to any special restrictions regarding their use and are available for application to the general purposes of the P.C.C. These include funds designated for a particular purpose by the P.C.C.
- These accounts include monetary transactions, assets and liabilities for which the P.C.C. can be held responsible. They do not include the accounts of other Church groups that owe an affiliation to another body, nor those that are informal gatherings of church members. Subject to the above, receipts and payments include income as received and expenditure when irrevocably paid.
- The amounts shown as 'planned giving' represent the amounts collected via Standing Order into our Bank Account and through the Church Of England's Parish Giving Scheme Scheme (PGS). Regular giving to the Foodbank and CPSM are included under those headings and not shown here. Of the General Fund amount, the following was NOT Gift Aided-

By Standing Order = £5,291 Through Parish Giving Scheme = £4,086

- Other Receipts is the total from section 6. Other Receipts less the amount shown in Voluntary Receipts above as Planned Giving and Gift Aid Recovered to avoid double counting. This is because the planned Giving and Gift Aid are included under the appropriate line in section 6 but are required to be recorded separately under Voluntary Receipts.

In this account, expenditure in these categories is recorded under appropriate budget headings and the reimbursement received at year end is recorded as income under these same headings.
