2. Role Purpose

General

- To collaborate within the deanery in mission and ministry and in such reshaping of ministry as resources and opportunities may require.
- To work with the PCCs towards the development of the local church in line with each parish's vision and the Diocesan strategy.
- To build on each church's passion for drawing people into a life of faith and hope, so that these parishes may be a place and community of Christian hope, spirituality and discovery.
- To seek ecumenical cooperation wherever possible.
- To gain a good working understanding of the Diocese and the support it provides.
- To encourage Christian stewardship of people's time, money and abilities so that the ministry of the church is strengthened and enabled.
- Whilst maintaining a distinctively Christian witness, to make new positive links and develop the existing links with community and external organisations based in the parish, so that full use is made of opportunities for outreach and service to the community.

3. Specific

These parishes are looking for a priest who will

- Lead us through the LYCiG process and help us to bring about generational change
- Teach us how to express our spirituality and understand our calling to faith
- Engage confidently with families, children and young people; and also develop an active presence within our local schools and community organisations
- Work constructively with our ecumenical partners and establish an obvious presence in our villages
- Encourage and appreciate the contribution of all members of our varied congregations

• Serve effectively as a Foundation Governor at South Crosland Church of England voluntary aided Junior School and also make links with our other schools as appropriate

4. Role context and any other relevant information

This benefice has recently closed one of its two Anglican church buildings, and are focusing ministry through the remaining building of St Paul, Armitage Bridge, and through their excellent relationships with local Methodist churches. The congregations are hopeful and ready to move forward under the leadership of a new priest, and keen to see their church grow in number and depth of discipleship, to see their links with schools and community organisations flourish.
