

TRURO CATHEDRAL SAFEGUARDING COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

The committee exists to provide support and guidance to the Chapter as it fulfils its role in ensuring matters relating to all aspects of safeguarding in the cathedral are fit for purpose and communicated fully, internally and externally.

Specific areas include establishing/ensuring/confirming that:

- The correct policies, procedures and practices are in place for the protection of children and vulnerable adults in the cathedral;
- There is compliance with local, diocesan and national safeguarding policies and guidelines, and communication on this subject with both choir schools;
- Regular policy, procedures and practice reviews in line with new safeguarding developments and legislation take place;
- All staff and volunteers whose roles are subject to DBS checks go through the process, and that confidential records are kept appropriately for internal monitoring and external inspection by approved authorities when requested;
- Safeguarding training is undergone by staff and volunteers according to their roles in line with the safeguarding policy guidelines, and confidential records are kept for internal monitoring and external inspection by approved authorities when requested.
